

Brave Wings Fashion Show in Scottsdale

The first ever Brave Wings Fashion Show will help make a difference through fashion on Saturday, June 22, at the Venue Scottsdale. It will be hosted by Jackie Morales of 101.5 and Stacy Santelli of Future Stars Global Foundation will be the key note speaker. The show will benefit Sojourner Center, one of the nation's oldest and largest domestic violence shelters.

Located in Phoenix, Sojourner Center offers services to more than 3,000 women and children each year. The center provides shelter, food, and clothing to victims of domestic violence, as well as on-site child care, counseling and legal assistance. Unfortunately, there is a shortage of beds and the center is unable to support all of the families in need.
