We chose to display the cake and cake stands on clear acrylic pieces so that the cakes truly were the center of attention. The result was OUTSTANDING!

The first cake was designed by PJ South of <u>La Dolce Pesca</u>. We loved the orange, turquoise and metallic accents on the cake. You can't see them in this photo, but there were peacock feathers as well. It was beautiful! The next cake was designed by Tammie Coe of <u>Tammie Coe</u> <u>Cakes</u>. Golds, muted green-blues and shimmering beige colors were highlighted in the floral, stripe pattern and dragonfly details. Once again, a true masterpiece!
