All the ice cream is made in the shop with premium ingredients - there are no cut corners here! They also tend to have unusual flavors around holidays - turkey around Thanksgiving, Hot Dog flavored ice cream to celebrate summer, and beer around Father's Day. I have tried the turkey ice cream, and let me tell you - it was definitely unusual!



Nindi, a former pilot, and Carissa, a former barista, decided to open a business when not many people probably would entertain the thought. The economy wasn't the greatest, and they had one daughter and another soon-to-be born. It was a family business from the beginning - Nindi recounted a memory from their early days: "When we first opened we were closed on Mondays, but Carissa and I were here with the girls doing some work, and people were lining up outside wanting to buy ice cream.
