

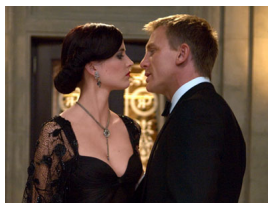
Inspectress Gadget: Xperia X10- Fit for a Bond Girl
