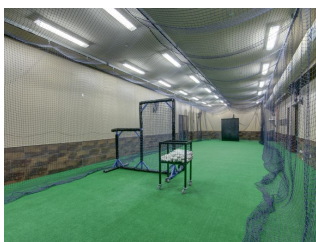
The luxury property in Glendale, AZ, in the gated community of Softwind Estates had been on the market for \$5.5 million.
