Westin Kierland's Adventure Pool is where the action is. (There is a heated adult pool, too.) For a more relaxing activity, wade along the 900-foot winding lazy river where you can take in waterfalls and beautiful desert landscape along the way. The little ones will love the splash pad that is only steps away from the main Adventure Pool, so parents can still keep on eye on the older kids who are swimming.
