The Gold Lounge



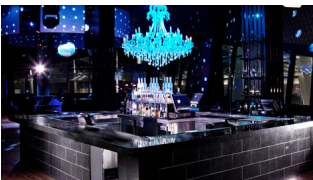

Aria Resort & Casino's new The Gold Lounge is inspired by The King's Graceland, even featuring design patterns found at his Memphis estate (after catching the wonderfully entertaining Viva Elvis by Cirque du Soleil at the resort, we recommend swinging my the lounge for a cocktail or two). Decked out in black and gold and spanning nearly 4,000 square feet, The Gold Lounge is undeniably glamorous. Haze Nightclub



Haze Nightclub, located inside Aria, is much more than a club; it also headlines some of today's top musical acts, like Usher and Estelle who have both already performed at the venue. (Timbaland and OneRepublic are both scheduled to hit the Haze stage in the coming weeks.) The two-story, 25,500-sq.-ft. space features state-of-the-art technology including a 20-foot wall of lights, top-notch sound systems and five motorized trusses that are suspended over the dance floor. And with three full-service bars and intimate seating, you never have to walk too far to grab a drink and rest your tired tootsies.
