Bugatti Veyron Fbg par Hermès



We can't begin to talk about luxury cars without mention of the Bugatti Veyron. The speedy sports car, topping out at 253 mph, takes its name from French race car driver Pierre Veyron and is known as the fastest luxury sports car in the world (think 370 feet per second). This year, the company teamed up with the famous French fashion house Hermès to develop the Bugatti Veyron Fbg par Hermès. Future: Cessna Citation Columbus



Announced earlier this year is the Cessna Citation Columbus, Cessna's largest business jet. Capable of trans-continental travel, it can accommodate up to 10 passengers and has an expected delivery date of 2014 and a \$27 million entry price point.

Future: Dassault Falcon 900LX
