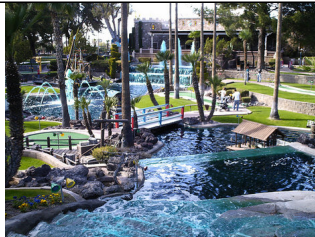

Golf N' Stuff

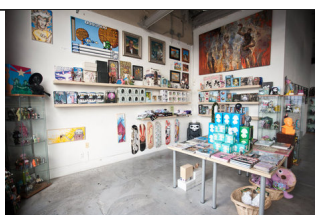
