In addition to the entertainment, A Night in Italy will offer a fantastic raffle for guests to bid on as well. A portion of the money will benefit the Desert Kids Safety program, which provides protection items for children such items as booster seats, bike helmets, gun locks and child identification services. In all, the proceeds will go toward providing ventilators and miniature-sized monitoring equipment in the TMC's Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, overnight chair beds for parents to stay nearby their seriously ill children, isolettes for transporting sick newborn babies and bike helmets for Desert Kids Safety program.
