CB2 also features sharable desserts like Cayton's Doughnuts and a chocolate chip and hazelnut Cast Iron Skillet Cookie. Finally, CB2 is offering four local craft beers on tap, beer by the bottle, wine and spirits.

Lunch is served daily at the restaurant from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. and dinner is served from 5 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday. Happy Hour, beginning at 3 p.m. daily, is also featured with an additional bar menu.
