After watching the Diamondbacks play ball in the heart of Downtown Phoenix's Chase Field, shoot over to one of these great dining spots for an after-game treat.

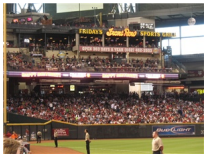


Hard Rock Cafe

TGI Friday's Front Row Sports Grill



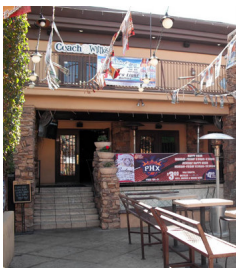
