If you don't exactly live by the "early to bed early to rise" philosophy, why not try the ranch's hour and a half evening horseback ride and cowboy barbecue (\$95 per person)? The event takes place every Saturday night and includes the buy-one-dinner-get-one-free senior dining special.

Let's be honest, you're not always in the mood for an adventure. For anyone just simply looking to relax (and who can blame you?), Tanque Verde Ranch also has a perfectly peaceful daily offer, which includes lunch and a 50-minute massage at their signature spa, La Sonora Spa (\$99 per person).



Not from around here? That's no problem, as the ranch has a great deal for tourists, too. One great promotion is the senior airfare special: just by staying at Tanque Verde Ranch through February (some date exclusions apply), you can receive an airfare credit, which includes up to \$300 for three nights, up to \$500 for five nights and up to \$700 for seven nights. When deciding on the details of your stay, the ranch's All-American plan, featuring mountain-view guest rooms, three meals each day and various scheduled daily activities, is another option to consider.
