Saturday, November 17, featured four different seminars, a tasting floor from 12 p.m. to 5 p.m., Happy Hour from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m., an Iron Chef Challenge, a cocktail dinner, a tequila dinner, and a nightcap in the Prema Lounge.

Sunday, November 18, features four more seminars, a tasting floor from 12 p.m. to 5 p.m., the Speedrack National Competition, a cocktail dinner and the 2nd Annual Southern AZ Classic featuring Arizona's best mixologists battling it out. Seminars include a ladies only Hands-on with Tony Abou-Ganim and an American Tiki Seminar.
