Painting in both watercolor and acrylic, Madaras has a diverse range of work from desert landscapes to expressionistic portraits. She understands and celebrates the subtle, natural beauty of ordinary scenes.

Madaras will be the first local artist to become a Miraval Artist in Residence. She will also be featuring two workshops: Masterpiece Made Easy and Creating a Mandala. In the workshops, guests will have the ability to create their own masterpieces and take them home.
