Two Valley Foundations Join to Raise \$20,000 Through "The Unbreakable Challenge"

The <u>David R. Sellers Foundation</u> (the 501(c)3 arm of <u>LGE Design Build</u>) has partnered with the Scott Keppel Foundation to raise \$20,000 towards their mission of helping those impacted by cancer, obesity, domestic violence and/or helping local pet shelters. Keppel is the owner of Scott's Training Systems (STS), a team of fitness and nutrition coaches based in Chandler, Ariz.

"Our Foundation has had a relationship with Scott Keppel and STS for many years and we were delighted to match the \$10,000 they raised with another \$10,000 from LGE Design Build," said David R. Sellers Foundation Director Carrie Masters. "Not only does STS provide personal training for many of LGE's employees but Scott and his team have been staunch supporters of our many fundraising efforts over the years."

Founded in 2014, the David R. Sellers Foundation has funded over 60 organizations. During the COVID-19 crisis, it funded numerous organizations including Global Orphan Hope, UMOM, Phoenix Rescue Mission, Child Crisis Center, The Joy Bus, Children's Advocacy Center of Collin County, Arizona Cancer Foundation for Children and Amanda Hope.
