"Animals are so important in our lives. They're so vulnerable and they rely on us to take care of them," Cecala said. "I love what the Arizona Humane Society is doing. They're finding forever homes for animals, and their spay/neuter programs are so important with the pet overpopulation crisis here in the Valley."

"I've always been a supporter of all animal rescue organizations, but I have a special affinity for the Arizona Humane Society because of its open-intake nature," Marconi said of AHS, which takes in all pets regardless of breed, age or medical condition. "This is an organization that helps hurt and injured animals with nowhere else to go. And without AHS, I fear what would happen to these animals, and I fear it wouldn't be good. I have two animals that came through AHS' Second Chance Animal Hospital, and I know without AHS, I wouldn't have these two amazing members of my family."
