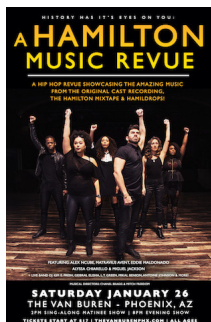
Elton John's Farewell Yellow Brick Road Tour
