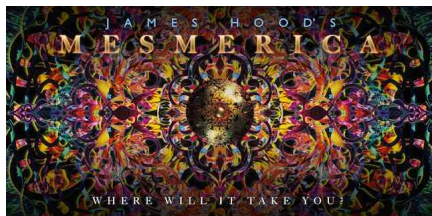
Hold your glasses up to cheers on your next date night at the Valley's top restaurants, resorts, music venues and many more during the weekend of July 26 to July 28.

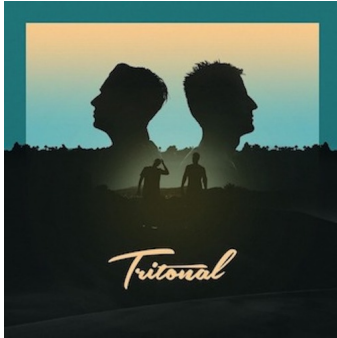

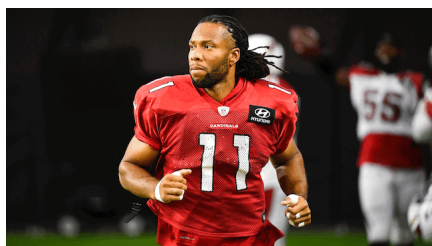
Tritonal at Maya Day + Night Club
