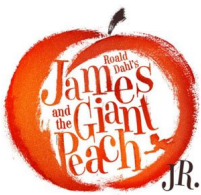
From having lunch with your favorite animals to enjoying a stunning view in the sky, there is something for everyone in the family the weekend of Jan. 24 to Jan. 26.

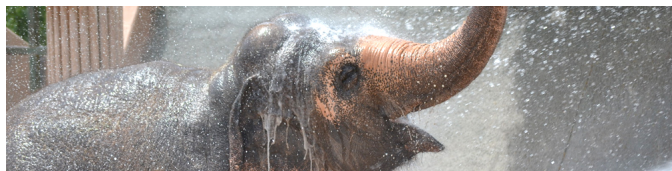
