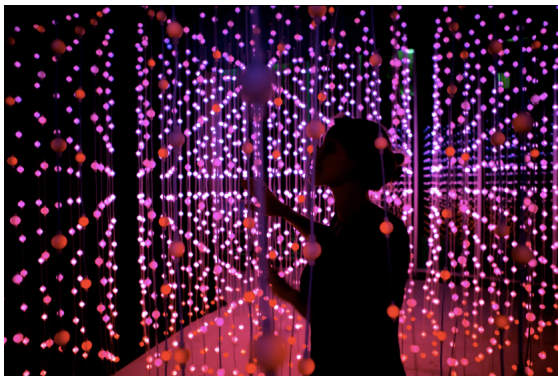

Scottsdale Wine Crawl

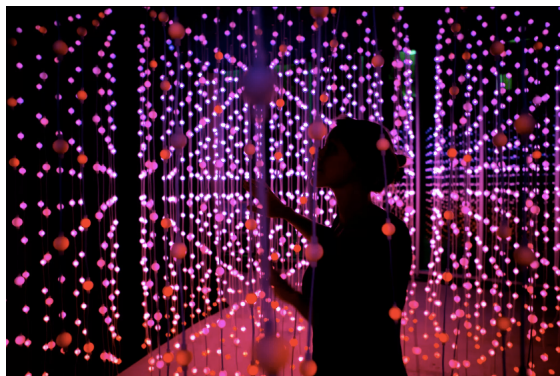
