Don't-miss attractions include The Diamond, where fans might spot MLB players and other recognizable faces; the National Baseball Hall of Fame & Museum to get a peek at one of the largest collections of artifacts on loan from the famed Cooperstown museum; and a stellar photo op with the World's Largest Baseball.
