

Introducing the 2012 Mercedes C-Class Coupe

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With a greater level of standard equipment, the brand new MY12 C-Class Coupe differentiates itself from the C-Class Sport Sedan.



This 302 horsepower two-door coupe has standard features that make this the ultimate car to drive. With a power tilt/sliding sunroof, LED daytime running and tail lamps, shift paddles, and split folding rear seats, this car makes for a more roomy experience. Included is a new infotainment system with features such as:

- *Blue tooth audio streaming

- *USM connectivity

- *HD radio

- *Central controller

- *5.8" high mounted screen

The C250 Sedan and Coupe come out this October. The C300 4MATIC, C350, and C63 AMG Sedans all come this month, August. The C350 and C63 AMG Coupes are available in September.



This 4.5" color instrument display will turn your windshield wipers on for you! Rain-sensing wipers and a HomeLink garage door opener is located on the front dash. Along with an integrated compass and auto-dimming rear view mirrors.

Mercedes' designers designed this coupe with comfort in mind. While sitting in the smooth leather seats, get used to the power drive and lumbar support. Not only are there fourteen different ways to adjust, but you can save them - switching to which ever one you feel like at that particular moment. While enjoying the view from inside the vehicle with a Burl walnut wood trim and trip computer, cruise around listening to the already-installed harman/kardon surround-sound system, a single disk CD and MP3 radio, an iPod/MP3 media interface and SiriusXM satellite radio (with six-month subscription).



So go head, take this ride for a spin and see how powerful this couple really is. As mentioned before, this 302 horsepower at 6,500 RPM car has 273 lb-ft of torque at 3,500 - 5,250 RPM. The car offers seven-speed driver adaptive automatic transmission with touch shift. Front, rear, and sport suspension make these cars adaptive so don't be afraid to push the pedal to the metal - you'll really feel the dual exhaust with two chrome outlets.



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Safety is always a priority so each car is equipped with a maintenance system, which supplies the buyer with 24-hour roadside assistance, SmartKey with panic button, and antitheft alarm with engine immobilizer. The 2012 C-Coupe presents front and rear outboard seatbelts with force limiters, dual two stage front airbags, side airbags, dual front pelvic airbags, drivers side knee airbag, and rear side airbags. Very rarely do cars have head protection curtains and active front head restraints like the Mercedes-Benz coupes have.
