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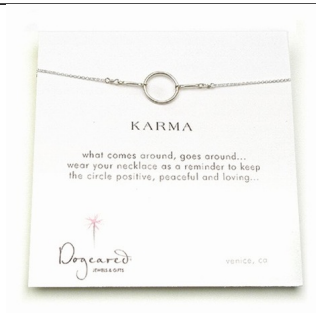


The best gifts are the one that continue to give. Here a list of great gifts that support charities around the world.

Glassbaby

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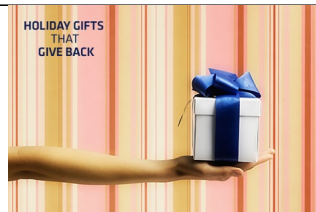
