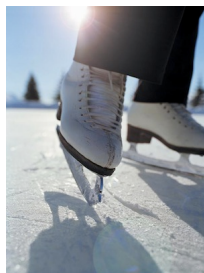


Phoenix Ice Skating Rinks

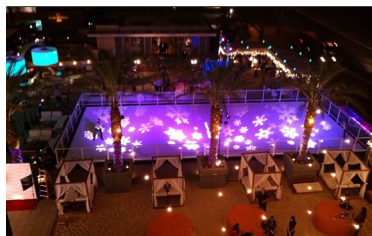


CityScape Phoenix Ice Rink
