The Residences at The Ritz-Carlton Dove Mountain - The Suite Life



Desert Highlands - Scottsdale Rock Star

Eight hundred and fifty acres of beautiful Sonoran terrain make up the luxury community of Desert Highlands (and the master plan has strived to preserve the desert vegetation, boulder formations and rock outcroppings). The Scottsdale master plan comprises 560 homesites and offers a fulfilling lifestyle for active families with activities including tennis, golf, a state-of-the-art fitness facility with a full schedule of exercise classes and an 83-degree members-only pool.

Join The Club

The location of the 30,000-sq.-ft. clubhouse at Desert Highlands is just as impressive as its amenities; it is placed at the base of Pinnacle Peak and a towering rock formation known as "Clubhouse Rock." 


Encanterra Country Club - The Pampered Life

Four distinct restaurants, Mossa Athletic Club, three pools and the full-service Alvea Spa can all be found at La Casa, which is reminiscent of a Mediterranean village. Encanterra Country Club residents hold social memberships to La Casa and have the option to purchase one of the golf memberships. Silverleaf offers 2,000 acres of luxury in North Scottsdale. Offering one of the most unique golf lifestyles in Arizona is the new Village at Silverleaf. Cullum Homes' The Village at Silverleaf will feature 12 semi-custom villas and seven club cottages that will sit adjacent to the first tee and driving range (contact Silverleaf for pricing). The architectural style of these 10 exclusive abodes reflects the clubhouse and will give residents walking access to the club, the golf course and all of the amenities offered there.

Join The Club

The 50,000-sq.-ft. Silverleaf Clubhouse boasts an eye-catching rural Mediterranean style, as well as A-list spa facilities, resort and lap pools, men's and women's locker rooms and a dining option to fit just about any taste and occasion. The private club features an 18-hole, 7,322- yard championship golf course designed by Tom Weiskopf. <u>silverleaf.com</u>.

Whisper Rock Estates - Desert Dreaming

For those who like to live large, Scottsdale's Whisper Rock Estates features custom homes that range in size from approximately 4,000 square feet to more than 10,000 square feet, with homesites spanning one to four acres. The landscape surrounding Whisper Rock features sandy bottom washes, boulder outcroppings and lush desert vegetation. Residents can enjoy five miles of walking paths; a three-acre private park with a ramada, tennis courts, a basketball court, a large turf area and fitness facility with a fitness pool; and the Caretaker's House, the social hub of the community.

Join The Club

For 13 years, the first course (designed by Phil Michelson and Gary Stephenson) at Whisper Rock has been a favorite of local golfers. (The second course, designed by Tom Fazio, and The Whisper Rock Golf Club itself, opened in early 2005.) The club offers a full caddy program and a "core" design with no housing within its routing. Note that Whisper Rock Golf Club is wholly separate from Whisper Rock Estates, and membership is available on a sponsorship-only basis. whisperrockestates.com



Vistancia - Posh Living in Peoria

Though it is brimming with elegance and a resort-caliber way of life, Blackstone at Vistancia is also a comfortable and relaxed community that has a little something for everyone. Peoria-based Blackstone at Vistancia is a 590-acre community within the 7,100- acre master plan and spotlights world-class dwellings by premier builders as well as custom homesites. For families, the neighborhood park at the guard-gated community is a huge draw, thanks to a half basketball court, a children's play structure, a recreational lawn and shade ramadas. Golfers flock to Blackstone at Vistancia's crown jewel: a private, 18-hole championship golf course designed by Jim Engh.

Trilogy at Vistancia is an active-adult community with three home collections— boasting an impressive 13 different floor plans. The homes fall into four architectural styles, including Tuscan, Spanish, Spanish Colonial and Desert Classic. The social center of the community is the Kiva Club, home to a Center for Higher Learning, artistic studios, an athletic club, a day spa, an aerobics studio, dining and an indoor lap pool and outdoor resort pool. The on-site Alvea Spa and Athletic Club is a prime spot for primping and pampering.

Fine and casual dining and a 24-hour fitness center with high-tech training equipment, a Pilates and yoga movement studio and a massage suite; a resort-style pool with private cabanas; a six-lane lap pool; a children's pool; and four lighted tennis courts attract residents to the 30,000-sq.-ft. Blackstone Country Club. Open to the public, Trilogy at Vistancia Golf Club is a daily fee course that stretches 7,225 glorious yards. vistancia.com.



Whitewing at Germann Estates - Gilbert's Greatest

Apart from the majestic homes, the landscaped open spaces, flowering shrubs, pretty Palo Verde trees and the internationally commissioned sculpture, "Passage" by Eric Higgs, provide plenty to please the eyes while driving or walking through Whitewing at Germann Estates. Verrado - All in the Family

Buckeye-based Verrado, one of the Valley's most family-friendly master plans, has launched its newest phase of development. Residents at 8,800-acre Verrado can look forward to 16 new parks, an elementary school, a dog park, the soonto- open Verrado Coffee and a massive new aquatic center that will debut next summer. (Heritage Swim Park will house multiple resort-style pools, a toddler splash pad area and a beach-entry play pool.) The final phase consists of 634 homes constructed by seven builders (some of which are new to Verrado).
