BEST LOUNGE

>>THE MINT

Occupying 7,000-plus square feet of prime location in Old Town Scottsdale, this “ultra lounge” is actually the former site of a bank—the obvious inspiration behind the name. With the bank’s old vault as a centerpiece, an expansive patio dotted with cabanas and a specialty Champagne bar in the co-ed restroom, The Mint’s atmosphere screams luxury. BEST BLOODY MARY

>>MORNING GLORY CAFE

BEST BLUES/JAZZ BAR

>>THE RHYTHM ROOM

BEST ARIZONA BREWERY

>>THAT BREWERY

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>>CADUCEUS CELLARS

Perhaps best known because of its famous owner, Tool musician Maynard James Keenan, Caduceus Cellars in Jerome has beaten the harsh Northern Arizona weather to produce truly memorable, award-winning wines in the last decade. BEST BAR TO FEED YOUR INNER CHILD

>>DAVE & BUSTER'S

This restaurant and arcade-game emporium is an entertainment-lover's dream. Created when two entrepreneurs, appropriately named Dave and Buster, joined forces to open a joint American-style eatery and arcade, Dave and Buster's has grown into a national favorite for both children and adults to come drink, eat and play. BEST HIPSTER BAR

>>LUX CENTRAL

Established in 2005, this stylish eatery in the heart of Downtown Phoenix has one mission: to provide high-quality food, drink and service while maintaining an atmosphere that encourages a love for art, music, design and culture in the Valley. BEST COCKTAILS

>>THE BREADFRUIT & RUM BAR

This award-winning restaurant in Downtown Phoenix is known for its eclectic and exciting cocktail menu, one that offers more than 150 carefully-curated cigars and rums. Guests can enjoy Jamaican-themed fare highlighted by sustainably-grown seafood, organic produce and locally-raised meats in an understated, elegant atmosphere. BEST COUGAR BAR

>>BLUE MARTINI

BEST COMEDY CLUB

>>TEMPE IMPROV

BEST WINE BAR

>>POSTINO WINECAFE

>>KOBALT

Filling a much-needed niche in the Phoenix community since 2006, Kobalt has grown into a preferred spot for Friday happy hours, karaoke and quirky events like Showtune Night and dart tournaments. BEST KARAOKE NIGHT
