Fear Farm

One of the largest and scariest haunted houses in the Valley, Phoenix-based Fear Farm includes attractions such as The Witch, Dark Carnival, the Bunker, the Undead and the Slaughterhouse. Tickets range from \$26.99 to \$33.99—depending on the day—and for only \$10 more you can add the Phoenix Haunted Hayride. Doors are open Sept. 30 to Oct. 31 from 7:30 to 10 p.m., Wednesday and Thursday, and 7 p.m. to 12 a.m., Friday through Sunday. Leading up to Halloween, Fear Farm will be open Oct. 23 to Oct. 26 from 7 to 10 p.m. and Oct. 27 to Oct. 31 from 7 p.m. to 12 a.m.
