

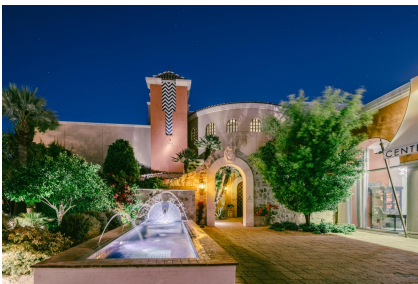

Revive Spa at the JW Marriott Desert Ridge is offering these two yummy treatments over the holidays. Treatments will be available through Jan. 31.

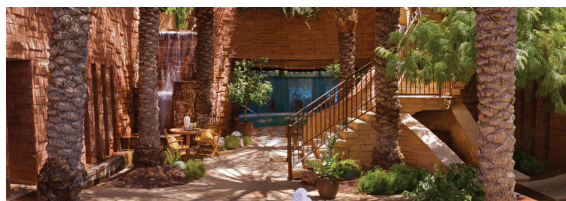
Hot Buttered Rum Body Wrap

Wine & Recline

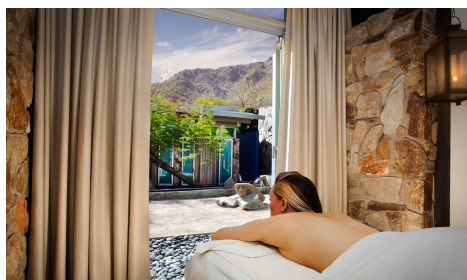

Signature Wakai Renewal

A Japanese word that means both “mature” and “youthful,” the concept of wakai is embodied in this aromatic ritual at Sanctuary Spa. The renewal process begins with a results-oriented exfoliation, bathing the body in nutrients and minerals which saturate the skin with intense moisturizers. The treatment includes a wrap with an anti-oxidant mask that helps to maintain skin’s youthfulness with anti-inflammatory properties. While wrapped, patrons will enjoy a scalp and neck massage with a revitalizing fresh berry serum, followed by a 30-minute full body massage using cloudberry – the highest known source of vitamin C.

Resurfacing Treatment

This replenishing treatment is a great option for ongoing care and deep exfoliation. This simple resurfacing treatment uses a glycolic solution to instantly dissolve dead skin layers and decongest blocked pores while targeting the repair of redness and irritation caused by daily environmental exposure. Those experiencing this treatment will notice that their skin is dramatically smoother, softer and more hydrated.
