Vans Warped Tour at Ak-Chin Pavilion

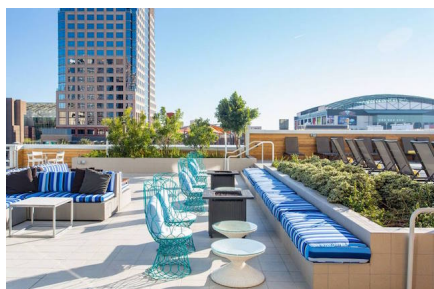

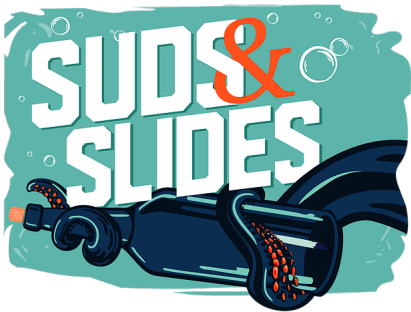

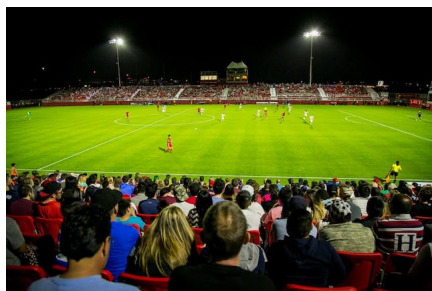
Brit Floyd at Comerica Theatre
