I waited most eagerly to see her newest collection; she tastefully displayed the new line in a gallery above her store; the collection was modern and militant. She took the classics and made them current with precious details and spot-on colors and marvelous fabric choices, while also adding vintage inspirations to make them feel absolutely timeless. Canvas trench coats with an avant garde cowl neck and military badges on the shoulder; a column dress in a marbled like cotton of white and grey with the most splendid black light weight cape that tied around the neck (one of my personal favorites).
