

Shades of Fall at Butterfly Wonderland

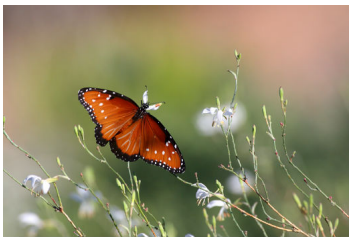
