Research shows that exposure to specific types of musical activities wires the brain for language, reading, math and motor skills while nurturing emotional and social development. Musicology is proud to be partnered with New Directions Institute For Infant Brain Development (NDI) founded by Dr. Jill Stamm. The innovative music curriculum is guided by research outlined in Dr. Stamm's bestselling book "Bright From The Start – The Simple, Science-Backed Way to Nurture Your Child's Developing Mind From Birth to Age 3."

What to Expect

Classes consist of a teacher leading a group of tots and parents / caregivers. First, everyone introduces himself or herself and their child and answers a question of the day, such as what their kid's favorite book is, their current nighttime routine or what the newest favorite toy is. This gives caregivers a chance to learn more about each other and evokes conversation amongst adults whom have kids around the same ages. Teachers then lead a themed class with such activities as singing / teaching new songs, dancing, playing with toys including new instruments, feathers, parachutes – anything that prompts creativity, learning and fun.
