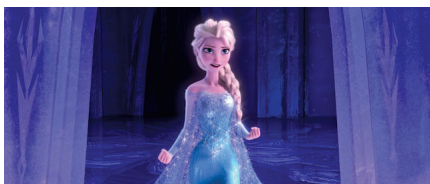
Star Wars
