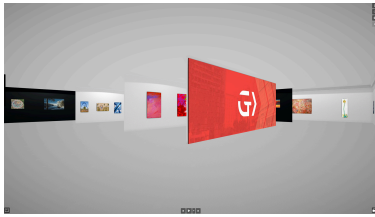


## The Greater Phoenix Economic Council Launches First Virtual Art Exhibition

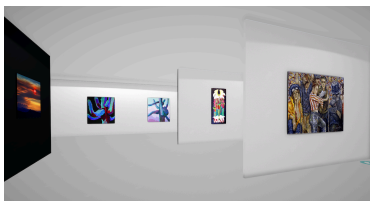
