
Levitated Mass & Art at the SMoCA

The film highlights the story of artist Michael Heizer, who has had an incredible career as a "Negative Space" sculptor and it was directed by Doug Pray. It explores the artist's creative process and the museums 10 day journey with an astronomical \$10-million price tag to bring his massive installation and brilliant sculpture *Levitated Mass* to life. *Levitated Mass* is a 340-ton diorite granite boulderaffixed above a 456-foot long concrete trench like structure *that is located on the* LACMA campus.
