

Admission to the special exhibitions during the March 6th First Friday event require a small fee, <u>Andy Warhol</u>: <u>Portraits</u> is only \$2, as well as <u>Leonardo da Vinci's Codex Leicester and The Power of Observation</u> - \$8 for Adults, \$5 for youth 6-17.
