Also the Festival and Scottsdale Public Art are debuting the recently commissioned interactive artwork "<u>SHIFTING SAND LAND</u>" by artist Bobby Zokaites, a recent M.F.A. graduate of ASU Herberger Institute for Design and the Arts. His artwork explores themes of adventure and childhood in his playful, large-scale spaces and objects. Shifting Sand Land is "Inspired by the video-game world of Super Mario Brothers and is an imaginative landscape of colorful platforms designed to keep people on their toes."



This year the Arizona Coyotes has sponsored the family area of the Scottsdale Arts Festival called Imagine Nation. This year's theme is "I Love Toys! FUN! Let's Play!" Providing engaging art projects and entertainment for children and their families offering a variety of sights, sounds, and hands-on art activities.
