

Big Band Dance and More at the Arizona Commemorative Air Force Museum

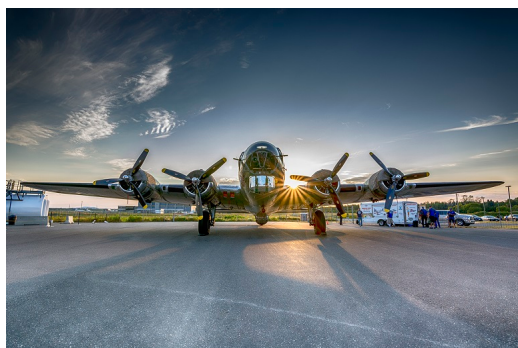
