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Half Moon is one of the finest resorts in the world. As an expansion to the children's programme, Half Moon recently opened Hype Zone an activity centre for teen. Hype Zone features a games room, cyber lounge, disco, movie theatre, and spa area and offers activities such as foosball, pool, air hockey, video games and mini-spa services. In addition to games and a teen spa offering manicures, pedicures facials and massages, Hype Zone also offers nightly entertainment such as karaoke, movie and disco nights.
