With seating for 235 guests, CORE Kitchen & Wine Bar features a lively open kitchen, indoor/outdoor dining, and settings that include an interactive chef's table, wine room and cellar, chef's counter, private dining room, and patio lounge close to CORE's own thriving citrus grove. The restaurant also adjoins the resort's Ignite Lounge and Bar, which offers 100-plus labels of smoky single malt Scotches and whiskeys from around the world.
