The 5 Browns

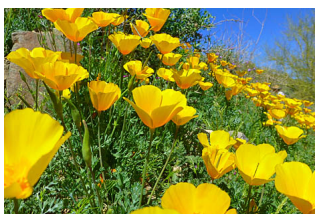
