Bodies Revealed

The overwhelmingly popular <u>Bodies Revealed</u> exhibit has opensed at OdySea in the Desert and explores the human body in an intimate and informative way. The 12,000-sq.-ft. exhibition will remain on display until March 2019. "Bodies Revealed" gives an in-depth view of the complex and intricate network of internal organs and systems in a very up-close and personal way, with more than 200 whole and partial preserved human body specimens. There are nine self-guided galleries, including The Skeletal System and Muscles and the Nervous System, each one providing a detailed look into a specific part of the body, its functions and its importance to the rest of the body.



Sonoran Safari at i.d.e.a. Museum

Head to i.d.e.a. Museum in Mesa to explore the artistic landscape of the world's 11th largest desert—the only place where the famous saguaro cactus grows in the wild—during the limited-time exhibit, <u>Sonoran Safari</u>. Through art and hands-on activities, guests learn about the desert's native plants, animals, reptiles and birds. Time's running out to see this exhibit; it's on view through May 27.



Dino Explorer at Legoland Discovery Center
