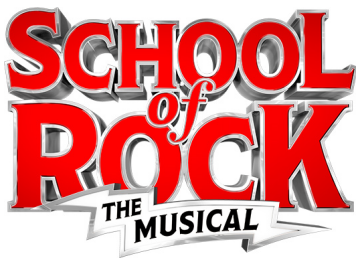

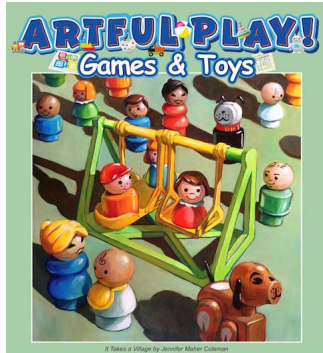

[Artful Play! Games & Toys at the i.d.e.a. Museum](#)

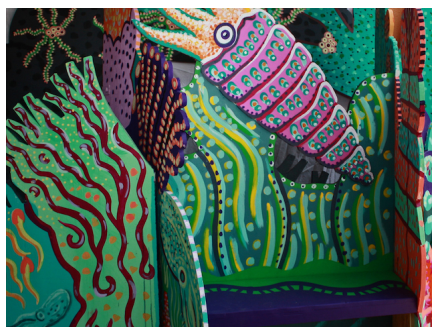
