INTERNATIONAL SUPERSTAR VIOLINIST DAVID GARRETT BRINGS HIS BRAND OF CLASSIC "ROCK SYMPHONIES" TO THE MASSES WITH HIS NORTH AMERICAN TOUR

Internationally renowned violinist David Garrett was recently touted by USA Today as being "on the edge of stardom in the USA". Looks like Garrett's time is now.
