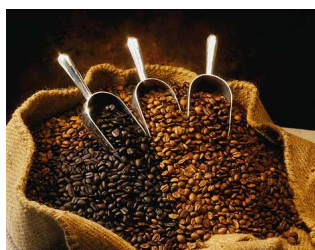
Press Coffee Food Wine
