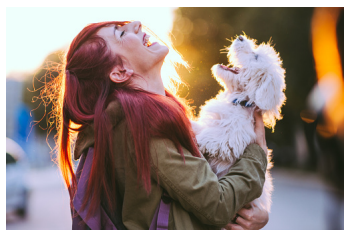


10 Spots for Dining with Your Dog in Phoenix
