These fabulous, eco-friendly homes consist of an Echo Solar PVT System (Valued at \$19,299) with a 120-gallon, super-efficient water heater at no additional cost. This specialized system generates two to three times more energy than your average solar PV system. Most solar energy homes use a solar PV system, which only allows 15% of the sun's energy to be captured. Rosewood Homes has invested their time and money into an Echo solar system. This system captures 50% of the sun's energy. Homeowner's receive sleek Energy Star appliances throughout the home and KCMA "Green Certified" Cabinets create the most up-to-date kitchen.

The perks of purchasing a home equipped with a solar electric systems through 2016, may qualify buyers for a one-time Federal Tax Credit of 30% of qualified system costs and a \$1,000 Arizona state tax credit totaling up to \$6,700.
