"The overall feel for the movie is the importance of family and after filming this movie," Sandoval says, "it has opened my eyes in my life, that I will never take one moment of being with my family for granted."

As far as the future goes for Shaina, the sky is the limit as she continues her search for bringing truth through her acting. "I am definitely going to continue my acting career. I am continuing acting classes and numerous auditions right now. I have been offered a role in another film, so we will see what the future holds."
