Make sure you check your spam folder or whitelist the domain "arizonafoothillsmagazine.com" or add no-reply@arizonafoothillsmagazine.com to your contacts list. If none of that works, send us an e-mail at dogdays@azfoothills.com from the e-mail address you're trying to register and we'll get you set up.

Q. I got logged out and I deleted the e-mail that had the password to log back in. What do I do?

No problem! Just enter your e-mail address where you did the first time to register your e-mail and it will send you another copy of the e-mail.
